



## **Competitions**

### **Accuracy Competition**

Artists of all levels are invited to join a 1 1/2 hour accuracy session and try their hand at an accurate drawing of the model. Drawings will be judged only on the accurate placement of the individual parts of the figure. No instruction is given.

Work during the model session must be executed with a #2 pencil on a 18" x 24" sheet of paper. Supplies will be provided. The figure must be sketched as large as possible within the frame of the paper while retaining accurate proportions. The model will sustain a single pose, breaking briefly twice. While observers are encouraged to attend, no outside advice may be given to contestants. In addition, no constructed devices may be used such as rulers, grids, cameras or projectors. However, drawings may retain remnants of any guide lines drawn free hand by artist during the session.

Winning entries will be displayed at the Smithsonian S. Dillon Ripley Center. All participants will receive a complimentary ticket to closing lecture and awards reception on Sun., Oct. 4 at 4:30 p.m.

- Entrance fee is \$55 and admission is on a space available basis only.
